Policies and Other Important Information

6.1 Payment Information

Tuition is due prior to the start of class each month. \$10 late fee after 5 days. We accept PayPal, Venmo, and Zelle (267-304-0860). QR codes provided. [QR Code Placeholders] All prepaid fees are non-refundable. Tuition must be current to participate in recitals.

6.2 Attendance Policy

Make-up classes allowed only for weather/studio cancellations. Students arriving more than 10 minutes late may be asked to observe. Students must attend at least 80% of classes to participate in the annual recital.

6.3 Code of Conduct

Respect instructors, peers, and studio. No gum or disruptive behavior. Parents observe only during designated times.

6.4 Injury

Injuries should be reported immediately; students may observe class to stay current. Medical clearance may be required.

6.5 Class Cancellations

Classes cancelled if schools close; notifications sent via text, email, and social media.

6.6 Ages 3-5 Participation Protocol

Young dancers are encouraged to try their best. Teachers use gentle redirection for non-participation or disruption. Parents are contacted if recurring issues arise; a supportive plan is created.
